History

On November 9th 1970, a 45 foot ~8ton sperm whale washed ashore on the South Florence, in Jetty Oregon.

The beach location under the was iurisdiction Oregon Department Transportation, née Oregon Highway



Division. Ideas to assist decomposition lead to the idea to blow up the whale. A charge of one-half short ton (lots) of dynamite was selected to break the carcass down and distribute pieces for nature to continue the decomposition process.

Detonation was at 3:45pm on November 12th, 1970. The explosion threw whale flesh around 800 feet in a hemisphere of directions. Needless to say, the idea didn't really work as desired, BUT most importantly, we celebrate this historical event for many reasons.

Unfortunately, in 1979, 41 sperm whales beached nearby on the same beach, state parks officials burned and buried them.
